Go through the traffic light, and take your
first right onto South Street.

Proceed up the hill to the next traffic light,
and take a right onto Springfield Street.

Elms College will be on your left.

From Route 91 South or North, Exit 9:

Take Route 391 North towards Chicopee.

Follow as above.
